TUES., AUGUST 14, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. HELP PICK THE BEST CANDIDATE TO RUN AGAINST GOV. WALKER IN NOVEMBER - will it be Evers, Vinehout, McCabe, Soglin, Mitchell, Royce, Pade or Flynn? We are offering no endorsements of primary candidates for Governor. The [Milwaukee Journal Sentinel](#) provides an informative voter guide.

For down-the-ballot candidates, the League of Conservation Voters has endorsed the following:

- Mandela Barnes for Lieutenant Gov. because of his voting on safe drinking water, breathable air, and preserving our natural resources for future generations. He also just won the statewide straw vote. The Cap Times, which rarely endorses primary candidates, also endorsed Barnes.
- Josh Kaul for Attorney General because he believes an attorney general should be serious about even-handedly enforcing our environmental laws. He also received the WEAC endorsement.
- Sarah Godlewski for Treasurer because she led the fight to preserve the State Treasurer's office. She believes the office is a crucial check on the Governor's power over Wisconsin's public lands. She also received the WEAC endorsement.
- No recommendation for Secretary of State. Candidates are 78 year old Doug La Follette who has held the office since 1983; and Arvina Martin who is 38, a member of the Ho Chunk Nation and a graduate of Dartmouth.
