School Board Elections Matter <u>TUES., Feb. 19</u>, polls open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. for <u>PRIMARY ELECTION</u> Three good candidates are running for the at-large seat on the Dodgeville School Board -- Jessica Thuli Wieczorek, Tonia Gregg and Darin Nagel. The top two vote getters will move on to the April General Election. Although Grassroots Citizens does not endorse

candidates, we have worked with Jessica Wieczorek as a member of our Grassroots Board for several years and, therefore, we know how committed she is to community service and our local schools.
