- [SB 6](#) - **requiring certain identification in order to vote** at a polling place or obtain an absentee ballot, verification of the addresses of electors, absentee...

- [SB 90/AB126](#) - **carrying a concealed weapon**; licenses authorizing persons to carry concealed weapons; possessing or transporting a firearm, bow, or crossbow under certain...
