<u>TO VOTE EARLY</u> (until Fri., August 10) go to your town, village or city clerk's office during office hours or contact your town clerk via phone to set up an appointment to vote.

FIND OUT IF YOU ARE IN A NEW CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT. Because of redistricting, Iowa County, most of Sauk, Lafayette and Green Counties are now in the 2nd Congressional District (currently represented by Tammy Baldwin.) On our website you'll find the new Congressional map and profiles of the 2nd Congressional Candidates -- Kelda Helen Roys (D), Matt Silverman (D), Dennis Hall (D), Mark Pocan (D), or Chad Lee (R).

FIND YOUR NEW STATE ASSEMBLY DISTRICT. For an enlarged new state



assembly map go to our <u>website</u>. There are many changes so be sure to check out who the candidates are in your new district - and what they stand for.

<u>District 51</u> (Dodgeville, Spring Green, Mineral Point, Lafayette County and the city of Monroe.) Your state assembly candidates are Pat Bomhack (D), Maureen May-Grimm (D), Howard Marklein (R)

<u>District 49</u> (now includes Montfort, Livingston and the rest of Grant County). You candidates include Carol Beals (D), **Travis Tranel** (R), **Dave Kuhle** (R)

<u>District 80</u> (now includes Ridgeway, Hollandale, Barneveld, among other areas).

You'll candidates include **Sondy Pope-Roberts** (D), **Charles Uphoff** (D), **Joseph S**.

Wineke (D), **Tom Lamberson** (R)

<u>District 81</u> (now includes Arena among other areas). Candidates are Fred Clark (D), Scott Frostman (R)

<u>STILL CONFUSED</u> about who will be on YOUR ballot? Here is an invaluable website. https://vpa.wi.gov/VoterSearchScreen.aspx. Enter your name and date of birth (or click on Address Search if you'd rather search by address). On the second screen, click on your name. On the third screen click on "View Sample Ballot" to see exactly who will be on YOUR ballot and how to contact YOUR clerk if you want to vote early.
