VOTE EARLY -- NOW THROUGH FRIDAY, JUNE 2, at 5 p.m. Avoid the lines on election day. Vote early for the June 5 election by going to your village or city clerk's office during office hours. If you live in a town, contact your town clerk via phone to set up an appointment to vote. If you are not registered to vote, take along your driver's license (if you have one) and a utility bill or some other proof that you live at your current address. Or you can request an absentee ballot by mail by contacting your clerk. DON'T KNOW WHO YOUR CITY, TOWN OR VILLAGE CLERK IS? Check out the Dodgeville Chronicle May 23 issue. Or go to https://vpa.wi.gov/VoterSearchScreen.aspx. Enter your name and date of birth, and at the bottom of the page that comes up you will find contact info for your municipal clerk.
